ORDER OF DISMISSAL


This matter comes to the Board of Appeals by way of an appeal filed by Pharmaceutics International, Inc. dated April 11, 2014 from a March, 21, 2014 Notice of Penalty Assessment, number NOPA 2014-002, in the amount of \$500.00, for discharge of wastewater with an acetone level of 51 mg/l (limit for acetone is 20 mg/l) on October 18, 2013.

WHEREAS, the Board is in receipt of a letter of voluntary withdrawal of appeal dated July 24, 2015, from Pharmaceutics International, Inc., Appellants, explaining that pursuant to email communication with R. Brady Locher, Assistant County Attorney, Baltimore County has agreed not to pursue the above referenced penalty (a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof); and


