Q: So this grant covers ALL expenses for everything? Doesn't that sounds too good to be true?

A: This is a GRANT program. In other words, there are no loans, costs, or obligations that any homeowners or tenants will be responsible for.

Q: What kind of work will be performed on the property to make it lead safe?

A: That depends. Each property will be reviewed by a licensed risk assessor to determine what scope of work will best suit each household. This may include window and door replacement, replacement of any finish work such as baseboards and molding, replacement of any other painted surface that may be a lead hazard, repainting of deteriorated surfaces, and any other work that will reduce the total lead hazard of the property to a safe level.

Q: Who will perform the work?

A: Our office has compiled a list of certified contractors that the home owner will be able to choose from

Q: Will I be able to live at the property while the work is being performed

A: It is highly recommended that any occupants allow us to relocate you during any lead abatement work. Relocation expenses are covered within the grant program. However, if any occupants wish to remain in the house, they may do so as long as they sign a waiver.

Q: Where will I stay if I am relocated?

A: Temporary housing will be chosen based on what is most convenient for the grantees.
