Hazard Control Blood Testing Form

It is recommended that all children under six years of age have their blood lead level tested prior to hazard control work in your home. If your children have not received a blood test in the past six **(6) months**, you should contact your child's primary health care provider or the local health department to arrange for a test.

Please check one of the following - the one which best describes your children:

_____ My child (ren) under six **have** had their blood lead levels tested in the past six **(6) months**.
I will provide the test results prior to the work scheduled in my home.

_____ My child(ren) under six **have not** had their blood lead levels tested in the past six (6) months and I agree to have them tested at this time. I will provide the test results prior to the work scheduled in my home.

_____ For religious and/or personal reasons, I choose **not to have** my child (children) tested for lead.
I/We voluntarily disclose this information. I/We understand that disclosure of this information is not required for participation in the Lead Safe Baltimore County Program.

NOTE: The use of a six (6) month time reference in this sample form assumes that it may take an additional two-three months from the time the owner applies for the program to the time that hazard control commences on a child's home. Thus the overall period between blood testing and hazard control would not exceed six (6) months.
