AN ACT concerning

Public Works - Notification

FOR the purpose of requiring the County to provide prior notice of certain road projects; specifying the methods of notification; requiring an annual list of certain projects to be provided; and generally relating to notice of certain road, highway, and alley projects.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

1           SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Baltimore County read as follows:

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4 §18-3-101 – Authority of the County.

5           (e) Control.

6           (1) The County may open, close, plan, construct, maintain, repair, improve,  
7 protect, preserve, alter relocate, straighten, widen, rebuild, and in general control all bridges,  
8 highways, roads, sidewalks, alleys, stormwater drains, and other facilities, appurtenances, or  
9 adjuncts that the county considers necessary or advisable in conjunction with the establishment  
10 and continuance of an efficient county road, bridge, sidewalk, and stormwater drainage system.

11           (2) PRIOR TO BEGINNING ANY PROJECT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR  
12 RESURFACING OF ANY ROAD, HIGHWAY, OR ALLEY, THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
13 WORKS SHALL:

14                   (I) PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTIFICATION OF THE PROJECT TO THE  
15 COUNTY COUNCILMEMBER IN WHOSE DISTRICT THE PROJECT IS LOCATED; AND

16                   (II) POST NOTICE OF THE PROJECT ON THE COUNTY WEBSITE.

17           (3) ON OR BEFORE JUNE 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DIRECTOR SHALL  
18 PROVIDE A LIST TO EACH COUNCILMEMBER OF ROAD RESURFACING PROJECTS  
19 IN THE MEMBER'S DISTRICT.

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21           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect forty-  
22 five (45) days after its enactment.
