AN ACT concerning

Speed Monitoring System

FOR the purpose of eliminating the restriction on the number of school zones in which the Police Department may develop a program for the use of speed monitoring systems; ~~requiring the Department to give a certain notice~~; and generally relating to speed monitoring systems in school zones.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 18-4-103
Article 18- Transportation
Title 4- Speed Monitoring Systems
Baltimore County Code 2003

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 18-4-103 of Article 18- Transportation, Title 4 - Speed
3 Monitoring Systems, of the Baltimore County Code 2003, be and it is hereby repealed and re-
4 enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

1 §18-4-103. Limited Use in School Zones.

2 (A) The Police Department, in consultation with other offices and departments of the county
3 government, may develop a program for the procurement, use and implementation of speed
4 monitoring systems in [not more than 15] school zones, in accordance with §21-809 of the
5 Transportation Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE
6 PORTABLE SPEED MONITORING SYSTEMS WHERE FEASIBLE.

7 ~~(B) BEFORE IMPLEMENTING A SPEED MONITORING SYSTEM IN A SCHOOL ZONE, THE~~
8 ~~DEPARTMENT SHALL GIVE WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY~~
9 ~~COUNCIL, AND THE SECRETARY TO THE COUNCIL, OF THE SCHOOL ZONE OR ZONES~~
10 ~~SELECTED. THE DEPARTMENT MAY IMPLEMENT THE SYSTEM UNLESS, WITHIN 14~~
11 ~~DAYS AFTER RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE, A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL~~
12 ~~REQUESTS THAT THE DEPARTMENT'S DECISION BE FORWARDED TO THE COUNCIL~~
13 ~~FOR APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL.~~

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
15 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on February 20, 2011.
