AN ACT concerning

Signs

FOR the purpose of permitting a freestanding enterprise sign in the ROA zones under certain conditions; and generally relating to enterprise signs.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 450.4.5(m)
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 450.4.5(m) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
