A BILL
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

Hucksters and Peddlers

FOR the purpose of requiring a person to be licensed in order to offer goods or services for rent in certain situations; and generally relating to hucksters and peddlers.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 21-11-101 (a)
Article 21 - Permits, Licenses, and Business Regulation
Title 11 - Hucksters and Peddlers
Baltimore County Code 2003

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY,
2 MARYLAND, that Section 21-11-101(a) of Article 21 - Permits, Licenses, and Business Regulation,
3 Title 11 - Hucksters and Peddlers, of the Baltimore County Code 2003, be and it is hereby repealed and
4 re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

1 §21- 11 - 101. License Required; Exception.

2 (a) In general. Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person shall be licensed by the Clerk of
3 the Court before the person may hawk, sell, peddle, vend, or offer for sale at retail, OR FOR RENT,
4 any fruits, vegetables, fish, meat, poultry, oysters, goods, wares, or merchandise or service of any kind:

5 (1) In or on the streets or highways of the county; or

6 (2) By going from house to house, either in a vehicle or on foot, on the streets or highways of
7 the county.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by the
9 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on May 2, 2011.
