AN ACT concerning

The 2007-2008 Capital Budget
P.A.L. Centers Capital Renovation

FOR the purpose of amending the 2007-2008 Capital Budget, by appropriating monies derived from a donation from the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services has made a grant award in the amount of \$56,391 available to Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks to be used for the renovation of outdoor basketball courts at three Police Athletic League Centers and signage at five Police Athletic League Centers; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Baltimore County Charter, the County Council may upon recommendations of the County Executive, amend the Capital Budget; now therefore

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Section
3 716 of the Baltimore County Charter, that the Capital Budget for Fiscal Year ending June
4 30, 2008, be and is hereby amended by appropriating Grant Funds made available through
5 a grant from the Maryland Department of Juvenile Services to the Baltimore County
6 Department of Recreation and Parks in the amount herein specified, to the following
7 program:

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed
10 by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect May 18,
