ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

The 2007-2008 Current Expense Budget
Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund
Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness

FOR the purpose of amending the 2007-2008 Current Expense Budget, by appropriating to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund monies derived from Federal funds and made available to the County through the Maryland Emergency Management Agency (“MEMA”).

WHEREAS, MEMA has made an award of Federal funds available to the Baltimore County Fire Department, to be used for Hazardous Materials Planning and Training; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County Council may accept gifts and grants, appropriate same to the Gifts and Grants Special Revenue Fund and expend the same, said fund having been established solely for the purpose of accounting for certain monetary gifts and grants made available to the County for

restricted purposes; and

WHEREAS, such fund remains open perpetually as a mechanism to account for the respective gift and grant appropriations and expenditures throughout the entire term of the grant period, including beyond the current expense budget fiscal year; now therefore

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Sections
3 306 and 712(a) of the Baltimore County Charter and Section 10-6-102 of the Baltimore
4 County Code, 2003, as amended, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending
5 June 30, 2008, be and is hereby amended by appropriating funds made available to the
6 Baltimore County Fire Department, in the amount herein specified, to the following
7 program:

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed
10 by the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect June 4,
11 2008.
