is hereby repealed and re-enacting, with amendments, to read as follows:

21-18-108. Penalty.

A person who violates the provisions of this title is [subject to a civil penalty of]  
GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT  
EXCEEDING \$100 for each violation.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect forty-  
five (45) days after its enactment.
