A BILL  
ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning

The 2009-2010 Current Expense Budget  
General Fund  
Community College of Baltimore County

FOR the purpose of amending the 2009-2010 Current Expense Budget by appropriating to the General Fund monies derived from unreserved, undesignated General Fund Surplus as of June 30, 2009; providing for the effective date of this Act.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 712 of the Baltimore County Charter, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations from unexpended and unencumbered funds set aside for contingencies in the county budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 16-305(d) of the Education Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that “in order for a board [of community college trustees] to receive an increase in the State share of support, the county share, in the aggregate, that supports the community college ... shall

equal or exceed the aggregate amount of operating fund appropriations made to the board by the county ... supporting the college in the previous fiscal year”; now therefore

1           SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred on it by Section 712 of the  
3 Baltimore County Charter, that the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010  
4 be and is hereby amended by appropriating unreserved, undesignated General Fund Surplus in the  
5 amount herein specified, to the following program:

7           SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having passed by the  
8 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on August 16, 2009 and  
9 shall apply retroactively to July 1, 2009.
