Signs

FOR the purpose of permitting a freestanding enterprise sign in the ROA zones under certain conditions; and generally relating to enterprise signs.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 450.4.5(m)
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended by Bill 3-07

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SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 450.4.5(m) of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended by Bill 3-07, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect 45 days after its enactment.
