AN ACT concerning

Zoning Regulations - Condominium Regimes

FOR the purpose of providing an exception to bulk regulations for certain approved condominium regimes.

By repealing and reenacting, with amendments

Section 209.8
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 209.8 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as
3 amended, be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

1 Section 209

2 O.T. (Office and Technology) Zone

3 § 209.8. Plans for O.T. (Office and Technology) Zones.

4 A. In an O.T. Zone, except as otherwise provided in Section 104.2 or 502.5, no building may
5 be constructed or altered unless the buildings and site conform to a plan approved by the County
6 Review Group as provided in Article 32, Title 4 of the Baltimore County Code. Except as otherwise
7 provided, approval of the plan is a condition precedent to the issuance of a building permit.

8 B. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISIONS OF THESE REGULATIONS TO THE
9 CONTRARY, THE BULK REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO AN APPROVED
10 DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR A CONDOMINIUM REGIME SHALL BE THE ONLY BULK
11 REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO A SUBSEQUENT CONVERSION OF THE ENTIRE
12 CONDOMINIUM REGIME, OR A PORTION THEREOF, TO INDIVIDUAL LOTS OF RECORD.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having passed by the
14 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on August 15, 2010.
