AN ACT concerning

Radio Operator Antennas

FOR the purpose of clarifying certain requirements of the zoning regulations relating to radio
operator antennas; and generally relating to radio operator antennas.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Section 426A D. and E.
Baltimore County Zoning Regulations

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 426A D. and E. of the Baltimore County Zoning
3 Regulations, as amended, be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as
4 follows:

1 Section 426A
2 Radio Operator Antennas

3 D. A radio operator antenna, ~~UNLESS MADE OF WIRE NO LARGER THAN THE~~
4 ~~SMALLEST DIAMETER SPECIFIED FOR THAT PURPOSE IN THE ELECTRICAL CODE~~, may
5 not extend closer than the front building line to any street on which the lot fronts. AN ANTENNA
6 MADE OF WIRE NO LARGER THAN THE SMALLEST DIAMETER SPECIFIED FOR THAT
7 PURPOSE IN THE ELECTRICAL CODE MAY NOT EXTEND FARTHER THAN THE
8 PROPERTY LINE OF THE LOT.

9 E. A SUPPORTING STRUCTURE PLUS ATTACHMENTS FOR A radio operator
10 antenna may not be higher than the lesser of 100 feet or the horizontal distance FROM THE BASE
11 OF THE STRUCTURE to the nearest property line [above] AT grade level.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect 45 days
13 after its enactment.
