FOR the purpose of amending the 2010-2011 Capital Budget and the Capital Improvement Program FY 2012-2016 by appropriating \$19,030,840 as authorized in Bills 32-10 and 34-10.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 716 of the Baltimore County Charter, the County Council may, upon recommendation of the County Executive, amend the Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 705 and 718 of the Baltimore County Charter, the voters of the county approved the borrowing authorized under Bills 32-10 and 34-10;

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, pursuant to the power and authority conferred upon it by Section 716 of

1 the Baltimore County Charter, that the Capital Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 be and
2 is hereby amended by appropriating in the amount herein specified to the following programs:

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that the “Appropriation Summary –
6 Capital Improvement Program FY 2012-2016” delineated throughout the “Capital Budget –
7 Supporting Detail”, as adopted in Sections 3 and 4 of Bill 27-10 is amended in accordance Section
8 1 of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. AND BE IT ENACTED, that this Act, having passed by the affirmative vote
10 of five members of the County Council, shall take effect November 28, 2010.
