AN ACT concerning

Address Numbers on Improved Property

FOR the purpose of establishing requirements regarding the display of address numbers on improved property; requiring address numbers to be displayed if there is a street providing public vehicular access to the rear of an improved property; establishing certain size requirements for address numerals or letters; and generally relating to the regulation of the display of address numbers on improved property.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 35-2-206 of Article 35 - Building and Housing, Title 2 -

1 Buildings, Subtitle 2 - Building Regulations, of the Baltimore County Code 2003, be and it is
2 hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

3 35-2-206. Address Numbers on Improved Property.

4 (b) Display.

5 The owner of improved property shall prominently display numerals or letters, AT
6 LEAST THREE INCHES IN HEIGHT, designating the address assigned to the property:

7 (1) in a conspicuous space on or about the property;

8 (2) on a conspicuous background; and

9 (3) in a location that is unobstructed and clearly visible:

10 (I) from the street named in the address of the property; AND

11 (II) FROM ANY STREET, ROAD OR ALLEY PROVIDING PUBLIC

12 VEHICULAR ACCESS TO THE REAR OF THE PROPERTY.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act shall take effect forty-
14 five days after its enactment.
