SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Section 259.11.B.4 is hereby added to the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, as amended, to read as follows:

3 4. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY PROVISION OF THIS SECTION OR ANY
4 OTHER COUNTY LAW OR REGULATION TO THE CONTRARY, A STANDARD
5 RESTAURANT, IN CONJUNCTION WITH OR IN ADDITION TO ITS OPERATION AS A
6 STANDARD RESTAURANT, MAY PROVIDE LIVE OR RECORDED ENTERTAINMENT.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having passed by the
8 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect November 28, 2010.
