FOR the purpose of clarifying the fine for parking in a space designated for the use of individuals

with disabilities.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments

Section 18-2-210
Article 18. Transportation
Baltimore County Code, 2003

1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND that Section 18-2-210 of Article 18. Transportation, of the Baltimore
3 County Code, 2003, as amended, be and it is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments to
4 read as follows:

1 § 18-2-210. Parking in spaces reserved for individuals with disabilities.

2 (a) A person may not park a motor vehicle in a space designated for the use of individuals with
3 disabilities, including on private property used by the public in general, unless the vehicle bears a
4 special registration plate, removable windshield placard, or a temporary removable windshield
5 placard for disabled individuals issued by the State Motor Vehicle Administration or as otherwise
6 provided under state law.

7 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor [and on conviction is subject to
8 a fine of \$75].

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act, having been passed by the
10 affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on December 15, 2008.
