AN ACT concerning

Depositing Materials in Streets - Penalties

FOR the purpose of specifying the penalties for violations of the statute prohibiting the placing of certain materials in roads; clarifying the application of the statute; and generally relating to penalties for placing materials on roads and streets of the County.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments

Article 18 - Transportation
Title 3 - Roads, Bridges, and Sidewalks
Baltimore County Code 2003

- 1 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE
2 COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the laws of Baltimore County, Maryland read as follows:
3 §18-3-109. Depositing certain material in the street.

1 (A) A person may not place, deposit, cast, or throw on, or into, ~~OR ADJACENT TO~~, any
2 road, street, sidewalk, lane, alley, bridge or drain in THE county:

3 (1) Any metal, wood, glass, nails, grass clippings, leaves, or other object or
4 article; or

5 (2) Any dead animal, offal, garbage, ashes, fruit, dirt, filth, rubbish, noxious fluid
6 or substance, or refuse of any kind.

7 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A
8 MISDEMEANOR AND SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$500 AND NOT MORE
9 THAN \$1,000, OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MONTHS, OR BOTH.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that this Act, having been passed by
11 the affirmative vote of five members of the County Council, shall take effect on April 20, 2015.
