Resolution No. 45-16

A RESOLUTION of the Baltimore County Council requesting the Planning Board and the Department of Public Works to review and update the County's Neighborhood Traffic Management Program.

WHEREAS, the Planning Board and the Department of Public Works, in response to a request from the County Council (Resolution 125-01), recommended the adoption of a Neighborhood Traffic Management Program for Baltimore County; and

WHEREAS, after public hearings on the subject, the County Council directed the Baltimore County Department of Public Works to implement a Neighborhood Traffic Management Program for the County in accordance with the Department's November, 2002 report (Resolution 42-03); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Council request, the Department updated the program in 2007 (Resolution 4-07); and

WHEREAS, the Department is required to file an annual report detailing the status of the implementation of the Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Council believes that this is an appropriate time to update the Program; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Planning Board and the Department of Public Works are requested to review the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program, with particular emphasis upon the criteria for which roads or streets may qualify for inclusion in the program, and on the question of whether neighborhoods in close proximity to the URDL should be considered for inclusion in the program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department shall report its findings and recommendations to the County Council on or before September 1, 2016.
