By the County Council, February 16, 2010

A RESOLUTION to approve the appropriation and use of state funds awarded under the Aging Schools Program of the Public School Construction Program to Baltimore County Public Schools in their FY2010 general operating budget.

WHEREAS, the Department of Education, Baltimore County Public Schools, proposes to accept the award and participate in the program described above (the “Program”); and

WHEREAS, Baltimore County Public Schools has been awarded \$874,227 on June 1, 2009, by the Interagency Committee on School Construction under the FY2010 Aging Schools Program of the Maryland Public School Construction Program to complete capital improvements, repairs, and maintenance of existing school buildings; and

WHEREAS, the Interagency Committee on School Construction has approved an extension of the approval of a contract award to September 2009 and an extension for the reimbursement deadline to March 2010 so that the exterior door replacement at Perry Hall Middle School can be completed and be eligible for reimbursement of up to \$300,000 to Baltimore County Public Schools for the FY2009 Aging Schools Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive of Baltimore County approved the Program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Article VII, Budgetary and Fiscal Procedures, Sec. 712, Supplementary and emergency appropriations, of the Charter of Baltimore County, Maryland, the

County Council, upon recommendation of the county executive on the advice of the county administrative offer, may make additional or supplementary appropriations from gifts or grants received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Annotated Code of Maryland, Education Article, §5-105 requires the County Council to authorize the source, amount and manner of spending of non-local funds received by the Board of Education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that in accordance with Article VII, § 712 of the Charter of Baltimore County, Maryland, and the Annotated Code of Maryland, Education Article, §5-105, the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland hereby expresses approval of the Program, as described above, and appropriates the award of state funds totaling \$1,174,227 for the current fiscal year; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its enactment.
