A RESOLUTION of the Baltimore County Council requesting the Baltimore County Planning Board to prepare a community plan for the North Point Peninsula area of Baltimore County.

WHEREAS, the Baltimore County Council adopted the Baltimore County Master Plan 2010 on February 22, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the North Point Peninsula, which includes the communities of Edgemere, Fort Howard, Miller's Island, and Beachwood Estates, is a vital part of the County's Seventh Councilmanic District; and

WHEREAS, a North Point Peninsula Community Plan was prepared in 2007 but not formally presented to and adopted by the Planning Board as a recommended amendment to the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the 2007 Plan contains a list of specific projects that promote the efforts of the Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, an effective community plan for the North Point Peninsula area will serve to promote the improvement of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Planning Board is requested to conduct an assessment of community needs and issues in the North Point Peninsula area, and to review and update the North Point Peninsula Community Plan 2007, with full opportunity for participation by the area's citizens, businesses, organizations and institutions, and to prepare a community plan for the area, suitable for adoption by the Planning Board and the County Council as part of and an amendment to the Master Plan.
