A RESOLUTION for the purpose of approving the extension of the sanitary sewer system of Baltimore County in the Carney Area, Eleventh Election District and Fifth Councilmanic District of Baltimore County.

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Environment Protection and Resource Management and the Director of Public Works have found it necessary, for the protection of the public health, that the sanitary sewer system of Baltimore County be extended in the Carney Area, Eleventh Election District and Fifth Councilmanic District, to serve three existing housing units in the area and all property owners affected have been given a hearing by the Department of Public Works and made aware of all costs that will be their responsibility; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 20-1-119 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, the County is authorized to construct such extension of said system without meeting the requirement that such project be self-supporting, provided the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland approves said extension by Resolution duly adopted; and

WHEREAS, the County Council deems it necessary for the protection of the public health that said sanitary sewer be constructed as aforesaid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the extension of the sanitary sewer of Baltimore County in the Carney Area, Eleventh Election District and Fifth Councilmanic District of Baltimore County is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its enactment.
