A RESOLUTION to approve a grant to Catonsville Heritage Foundation, Inc. as part of the Baltimore County Office of Community Conservation Action Grant Program.

WHEREAS, Baltimore County currently allocates funds for the Community Conservation Action Grant Program for the purpose of providing for community improvement projects throughout the Community Conservation areas of Baltimore County; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the Catonsville Heritage Foundation, Inc. be awarded a grant in the amount of \$7,500 for the purpose of procuring architectural design services for the restoration of the Lurman Tenant House; and

WHEREAS, these professional architectural services will be provided by Robert P. Brennan, AIA, CSI, principal, Brennan and Company; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Brennan will produce detailed drawings and a display model of a fully restored structure as an initial step in the restoration of the Lurman Tenant House; and

WHEREAS, Catonsville Heritage Foundation is a non-profit agency located in the Catonsville area of Baltimore County dedicated to preserving and commemorating the history and heritage of Catonsville.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Baltimore County fully supports and approves the grant to the Catonsville Heritage Foundation, Inc. in the amount of \$7,500.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its enactment.
