A RESOLUTION of the Baltimore County Council asking the Baltimore County Planning Board to prepare a Red Line Transit Corridor Plan in support of the Red Line Transit Project.

WHEREAS, the Baltimore County Master Plan 2010 recognizes the need to develop and maintain a comprehensive regional transit system, to coordinate land use and transportation planning, and to invest in new transportation infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Baltimore Regional Rail Plan identifies the Red Line Transit Project as a major step in developing a successful regional transit system; and

WHEREAS, the Red Line corridor extends from the Social Security complex in Woodlawn through Fells Point to the Bayview Medical Campus; and

WHEREAS, since 2004, the Mass Transit Administration has been working with the County and Baltimore City toward submission of a formal application to the Federal Transit Administration for preliminary design and engineering matching funds; and

WHEREAS, MTA plans to submit the preliminary design of the Red Line project to the Federal Transit Administration for approval in Summer 2009 requesting federal funding to continue the project with preliminary engineering; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND,

that the Baltimore County Planning Board is hereby requested to prepare a Red Line Transit Corridor Plan to serve as a guide for the integration of a transit project with any potential development of the Red Line corridor.
