A RESOLUTION of the Baltimore County Council to request the Planning Board to review the Turner Station Community Charrette Plan.

WHEREAS, the Baltimore County Council adopted the Baltimore County Master Plan 2010 on February 22, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Master Plan advocates the development and use of community plans for the established neighborhoods in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Turner Station Community Conservation Plan was adopted as an amendment to the Baltimore County Master Plan 2010 on December 15, 2003 (Res. 142-03); and

WHEREAS, the Turner Station Community Conservation Plan provided recommendations on Heritage Preservation, Housing, Infrastructure, Natural Environment and Recreation; and

WHEREAS, the preparation of the Turner Station Community Charrette Plan was built upon and refined the recommendations in the Turner Station Community Conservation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Turner Station Community Charrette Plan was prepared in close cooperation with the Turner Station community in June 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Charrette Plan was created by the Community Design Team in the Office of Planning using the charrette process to gain momentum and support for the plan, which has been positively received by the community; and

WHEREAS, the Charrette Plan proposes enhancements to green spaces, creation of walkable connections, a plan for housing rehabilitation, and improvements to gateways into the community; and

WHEREAS, the Charrette Plan will serve to promote the stabilization and improvement of the Turner Station community; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Turner Station Community Charrette Plan be reviewed by the Planning Board in order to be considered as an amendment to the Baltimore County Master Plan 2010.
