A RESOLUTION to endorse the filing of an application by the Dundalk Renaissance Corporation.

WHEREAS, the Baltimore County Council recognizes that there is a significant need for reinvestment and revitalization of the older communities of Baltimore County; and

WHEREAS, the Dundalk Renaissance Corporation proposes to file a Community Legacy application with the Department of Housing and Community Development, for a grant to support a project that includes its Energy Audit Implementation program, rain barrel program, and tree planting program; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Community Development, either through the Community Legacy Program or through other programs of the Department, or in cooperation with other state departments or agencies, may provide the financing for such programs; and

WHEREAS, the applicable law and regulations require approval by the governing body of Baltimore County of the filing of the application; and

WHEREAS, the area is located in a priority funding area, and the project will conform to the local zoning code; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Council hereby endorses the Community Legacy Program application filed by the Dundalk Renaissance Corporation and the area designation and project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive be and is hereby requested to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating his approval thereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this Resolution be forwarded to the Secretary of the Department of Housing and Community Development of the State of Maryland.
