A RESOLUTION to adopt a Public School Recycling Amendment to the Baltimore County Solid Waste Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, Environment Article, § 9-1703, the County is required to address, in the Solid Waste Management Plan, the strategy for the collection, processing, marketing, and disposition of recyclable materials from county public schools; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County should adopt a Public School Recycling Amendment to its Solid Waste Management Plan to address the above; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment to the Baltimore County Solid Waste Management Plan has been formulated, a public hearing was held on June 16, 2010, and the public has been given reasonable opportunity to comment on the proposed Amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland, that the Public School Recycling Amendment to the Baltimore County Solid Waste Management Plan is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution shall be submitted to the County Executive for his approval and the same shall take effect from the date of approval.
