A RESOLUTION to purchase easements under the Imminently Threatened Farm Preservation Program.

WHEREAS, the Imminently Threatened Farm Preservation Program authorizes the county to purchase agricultural preservation easements for farms without regard to the priority ranking list then in effect; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Protection and Resource Management, upon recommendation of the Agricultural Land Preservation Advisory Board, has determined that the threats to a farm owned by Alexander B. Page, III and Joan A. Page are sufficient to proceed with the purchase of an easement under the Imminently Threatened Farm Preservation Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that in accordance with Section 24-3-204(c)(2)(i) of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, as amended, the County Council approves the county purchase of an agricultural land preservation easement over a farm owned by Alexander B. Page, III and Joan A. Page, without regard to the priority ranking lists, subject to the approval of a completed easement contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its enactment.
