A RESOLUTION to endorse the application of CASA of Baltimore County, Inc., to the State of Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program for certain tax credits to provide funding for the administration and facilitation of the housing counseling program that provides volunteers who serve as Court Appointed Special Advocates in juvenile court.

WHEREAS, CASA of Baltimore County, Inc. is a non-profit agency dedicated to improving the lives of Baltimore County children involved in abuse and neglect proceedings in juvenile court; and

WHEREAS, CASA of Baltimore County, Inc. has applied to the State of Maryland for an allocation of tax credits under the Community Investment Tax Credit Program to be used to fund the administration of the Court Appointed Special Advocate Program; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland requires, as part of the application process, the local governing bodies endorse proposals submitted to the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland, that Baltimore County fully supports and endorses the application of CASA of Baltimore County, Inc. for an allocation of tax credits to be issued under the Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect from the date of its enactment.
