A RESOLUTION to authorize the County to accept a gift of 500 doses of measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine, 200 doses of varicella vaccine and 5,000 doses of trivalent seasonal influenza vaccine for the use of the Baltimore County Department of Health.

WHEREAS, the Baltimore County Department of Health has received a gift of 500 doses of measles, mumps, and rubella vaccine, 200 doses of varicella vaccine and 5,000 doses of trivalent seasonal influenza vaccine valued at \$69,227 from the Maryland Department of Health and Mental Hygiene through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act to be administered to susceptible Baltimore County Department of Health and Baltimore County Fire Department healthcare personnel or to the public by the Baltimore County Department of Health or through partnerships with Baltimore County hospitals; and

WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Baltimore County Charter vests in the County Council the power to accept gifts and grants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the County be and is hereby authorized to accept the gift of 500 doses of measles, mumps and rubella vaccine, 200 doses of varicella vaccine and 5,000 doses of trivalent seasonal influenza vaccine for the use of the Baltimore County Department of Health; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its enactment.
