A RESOLUTION to authorize the County to accept a gift from Ann Mace Carlton, Richard H. Carlton, Jr., Elizabeth Carlton Crosby, M. Carroll Mace, Samuel Veirs Mace, Robert Johnson Mace, Albert Patrick Mace, Patrick Mace Azaro, and Carville Viers Mace (hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Donors”), of a parcel of land containing 0.966 acres of land, as more fully described on the attached Exhibit “A” (the Property).

WHEREAS, the Donors are heirs of Carville C. Mace and Albert J. Mace and have no interest in continued ownership of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability is desirous of the County obtaining fee simple title to the Property as it is contiguous to 2 parcels of land owned by Baltimore County that were purchased in 2000 and 2001 through the Baltimore County Conservation Easement program for the protection of rural natural resources and other governmental purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Baltimore County Charter vests in the County Council the power to accept gifts and grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland, that the County be and is hereby authorized to accept as a gift from Ann Mace

Carlton, Richard H. Carlton, Jr., Elizabeth Carlton Crosby, M. Carroll Mace, Samuel Veirs Mace, Robert Johnson Mace, Albert Patrick Mace, Patrick Mace Azaro, and Carville Viers Mace, a parcel of land containing 0.966 acres of land, more or less, upon such terms and conditions as may be deemed necessary or appropriate by the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its enactment.
