A RESOLUTION to endorse the application of the North Point Village Civic Association, Inc. (“NPVCA”) to the State of Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program for certain tax credits to provide operating funds; and

WHEREAS, NPVCA is a non-profit civic association located in the North Point Village area of Dundalk; and

WHEREAS, the target population for these projects from NPVCA includes residents in North Point Village and Dundalk and will also specifically target elderly and youth living in these areas for certain projects; and

WHEREAS, by providing: insurance required to maintain the youth programs; a program for the elderly which would offer daytime activities; assistance in creating a positive appearance of the area; and funds for low-income homeowners to help with minor repairs to keep them in their homes, NPVCA will continue to provide the youth with beneficial programs, the elderly with activities such as card playing, bingo, bus trips and possibly food and toiletries all within walking distance of a local recreation center, mulching of the common areas, an additional dumpster day, signs to increase safety, and assistance to low – income home owners for minor home repairs to help them stay in their homes; and

WHEREAS, NPVCA has applied to the State of Maryland for an allocation of tax credits in the amount of \$20,000 over two (2) years under the Community Investment Tax Credit Program to be used to fund community enhancements that will serve approximately 3,771 residents of North Point Village and 54,967 residents of Dundalk; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland requires, as part of the application process, that local governing bodies endorse proposals submitted to the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland, that the County fully supports and endorses the application of NPVCA for an allocation of tax credits to be issued under the Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
