A RESOLUTION to approve a grant to Dundalk Renaissance Corporation from Baltimore County Department of Planning, Neighborhood Improvement Division.

WHEREAS, Dundalk Renaissance Corporation is a non-profit corporation whose mission is to promote and revitalize the Dundalk Community; and

WHEREAS, Dundalk Renaissance Corporation's activities include: organizing and participating in community-building events primarily in the Main Street commercial area; serving as a resource and support to Main Street businesses and the adjoining neighborhoods; promoting a more positive image of the community through improved marketing and continued development of the "My Town Dundalk" positioning campaign; and leadership on planning and development issues as they arise; and

WHEREAS, Dundalk Renaissance Corporation has applied for a grant in the amount of \$50,000.00 which will support salaries and fringe costs for two (2) primary staff; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Council hereby approves the grant to Dundalk Renaissance Corporation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
