A RESOLUTION to authorize the County to accept a gift for the use of Baltimore County, Maryland.

WHEREAS, the Police Department received a gift of various pieces of fitness equipment, (list attached) to be housed and utilized by the police officers at Precinct 2, Woodlawn. The total value for this equipment is \$28,435.16 and escrow for any repairs/maintenance is \$1,564.84. Precinct 2, Woodlawn also received a donation of used equipment from the Police Community Relations Council in the amount of \$1,900.00. The total value of all equipment is \$30,335.16 plus the \$1,564.84 which will remain in the Police Community Relations Council account for repairs/maintenance. The total value of the donation is \$31,900.00. This equipment has been purchased by the Precinct 2, Woodlawn Police and Community Relations Council and will be donated to the Baltimore County Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Baltimore County Charter vests in the County Council the power to accept gifts and grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland, that the County be and is hereby authorized to accept the gift of this fitness equipment donated by the Baltimore County Police and Community Relations Council (Precinct 2, Woodlawn) for the use by the Police Department of Baltimore County, Precinct 2, Woodlawn

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
