A RESOLUTION of the Baltimore County Council to amend the Baltimore County Water Supply and Sewerage Plan.

WHEREAS, the Planning Board has considered requests for amendments to the Baltimore County Water and Sewerage Plan, and has received recommendations from the Department of Public Works, the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability, and the Department of Planning and has reviewed the requested amendments in accordance with the Executive Order concerning the Water and Sewerage Plan Amendment Process dated April 11, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Board did on July 18, 2013 hold an advertised public hearing on the requests for amendments; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned County agencies did review the requests for amendments and made recommendations, which were considered by the Planning Board and reviewed by the County Executive; and

WHEREAS, the requests for amendments are now before the County Council; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, that the Baltimore County Water Supply and Sewerage Plan, as amended, be and it is hereby further amended as follows:

1. The maps attached hereto and made a part hereof marked Exhibit 1 entitled “Oheb Shalom Cemetery” are hereby approved and the areal designations thereof are revised to W-3 / S-3 on the D.R.2 zoned portion of the property subject to a change in the URDL that corresponds to the D.R.2 zoned portion of the property; and
2. The maps attached hereto and made a part hereof marked Exhibit 2 entitled “Dyer Property

Access” are hereby approved and the areal designations thereof are revised to W-3 / S-7 along Berrymans Lane and Nicodemus Road subject to a change in the URDL to allow public water to be extended in the existing road bed to serve the property; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution be submitted to the County Executive for his approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution and the attached exhibits be submitted to the State Department of the Environment; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
