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A RESOLUTION to approve a grant to Dundalk Renaissance Corporation from Baltimore County Department of Planning.

WHEREAS, Dundalk Renaissance Corporation is a non-profit corporation whose mission is to promote and revitalize the Dundalk Community; and

WHEREAS, Dundalk Renaissance Corporation is a County certified Community Housing Development Organization (“CHDO”), and has submitted two (2) applications for Financial Assistance to the Department of Planning totaling up to \$532,500. The funds will be used for hard costs associated with the renovation and redevelopment of four (4) properties in the Dundalk Community: 26 Admiral Blvd, 9 Arrowship Road, 3032 Liberty Parkway, and 6825 Dunhill Road; and

WHEREAS, the project will include a major renovation of each property to provide additional space so the houses can be subsequently sold to individuals or families whose household income does not exceed 80% of the Area Household Median Income as determined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) and the funding source will be the Home Investment Partnership Program (“HOME”).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE  
COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Baltimore County Council hereby approves the grant  
to Dundalk Renaissance Corporation.
