A RESOLUTION for the purpose of approving the extension of the sanitary sewer system of Baltimore County in the Perry Hall Area, Eleventh Election District and Fifth Council District of Baltimore County.

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Environmental Protection and Sustainability and the Director of Public Works have found it necessary, for the protection of the public health, that the sanitary sewer system of Baltimore County be extended in the Perry Hall Area, Eleventh Election District and Fifth Council District, to serve nine existing housing units and zero commercial properties in the area and all property owners affected have been given a hearing by the Department of Public Works and made aware of all costs that will be their responsibility; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority contained in Section 20-1-119 of the Baltimore County Code, 2003, the County is authorized to construct such extension of said system without meeting the requirement that such project be self-supporting, provided the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland approves said extension by Resolution duly adopted; and

WHEREAS, the County Council deems it necessary for the protection of the public health that said sanitary sewer system be constructed as aforesaid; now therefore

RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that it hereby approves the extension of the sanitary sewer of Baltimore County in the Perry Hall Area, Eleventh Election District and Fifth Council District of Baltimore County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
