A RESOLUTION to endorse the application of Linwood Center, Inc. to the Department of Housing and Community Development for a grant for a local project.

WHEREAS, Baltimore County is interested in promoting charitable donations to nonprofit organizations in the County; and

WHEREAS, Linwood Center, Inc. is a nonprofit organization in Ellicott City, Maryland, and is a special education school and residential program for individuals living with autism and related developmental disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Linwood Center owns and operates five properties in the Catonsville community of Baltimore County that provide residential support services to children and adults living with autism and related developmental disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Linwood Center has applied for a \$30,000 Community Investment Tax Credit grant from the Department of Housing and Community Development to be used for improvements and renovations to these Baltimore County properties, and

WHEREAS, the regulations of the Community Investment Tax Credit Program require that all projects receiving a grant be approved and supported by the governing body of the County in which the project is situated; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that Baltimore County supports and endorses the application of Lindwood Center, Inc. for a grant to be issued by the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive is requested to endorse this Resolution, thereby indicating his approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development, Division of Neighborhood Revitalization, 2 Charles Street, Suite 450, Baltimore, Maryland 21201; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
