A RESOLUTION to endorse the application of CASA of Baltimore County, Inc. (“CASA”) to the State of Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program for certain tax credits.

WHEREAS, CASA is a non-profit corporation that provides trained volunteers to serve as court appointed advocates for children who have been taken from their homes and are in the foster care system due to abuse or neglect; and

WHEREAS, CASA has applied to the State of Maryland for an allocation of tax credits in the amount of \$15,000 under the Community Investment Tax Credit Program to raise funds to recruit, screen, train, and supervise community volunteers to serve as court-appointed advocates for abused and neglected children from priority funding areas in Baltimore County; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland requires, as part of the application process, that local governing bodies endorse proposals submitted to the Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland, that the County fully supports and endorses the application of CASA

for an allocation of tax credits to be issued under the Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
