A RESOLUTION of the Baltimore County Council in support of a pilot program for the Towson Circulator, to be conducted by the Maryland Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, the concept of a free, north-south bus circulator route along York Road in the Towson core has been discussed and studied for several years; and

WHEREAS, a transit circulator can be part of a comprehensive transportation strategy for Towson that includes better roads and bicycle and pedestrian connections; and

WHEREAS, the circulator would be modeled on the Baltimore City Charm City Circulator and would be state and county-funded; and

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Transportation has convened a Towson Circulator Feasibility Study Advisory Group which has met and will continue to meet through November, 2015; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, by the County Council of Baltimore County, Maryland that the County Council supports and encourages the development of a pilot program for the Towson Circulator, subject to extensive input from neighborhoods regarding routes and other aspects of operation; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be sent to the Maryland Department of Transportation.
