A RESOLUTION to adopt a Special Events Recycling Amendment to the Baltimore County Solid Waste Management Plan.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Annotated Code of Maryland, Environment Article, §9-1712, the County is required to include language in the Solid Waste Management Plan on the collection and recycling of recyclable materials from special events that include temporary use of a public street, publicly owned site or facility, or public park; serve food or drink; and expect to have 200 or more persons in attendance; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the County should adopt a Special Events Recycling Amendment to its Solid Waste Management Plan to address the above; and

WHEREAS, the Amendment to the Baltimore County Solid Waste Management Plan has been formulated, a public hearing was held on October 13, 2015, and the public has been given reasonable opportunity to comment on the proposed Amendment,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Special Events Recycling Amendment to the Baltimore County Solid Waste Management Plan is hereby approved.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution shall be submitted to the County Executive for his approval and the same shall take effect from the date of his approval.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the Special Events Recycling Amendment to the Baltimore County Solid Waste Management Plan, along with a copy of this Resolution, be submitted to the Maryland Department of the Environment.
