A RESOLUTION to authorize the County to accept a gift of an all-inclusive playground and amphitheater facility on the grounds of Angel Park from the Perry Hall Recreation & Parks Council.

WHEREAS, the County is the fee simple owner of certain real property on Honeygo Boulevard in the 11th Election District of Baltimore County, Maryland containing approximately 2.375 acres (the “Premises”); and

WHEREAS, the Perry Hall Recreation & Parks Council (the “Council”) is a volunteer organization dedicated to providing quality recreational and leisure opportunities such as individual and team sports, arts and crafts, social clubs and activities to the citizens of Perry Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to lease the Premises from the County to construct an all-inclusive playground and amphitheater facility thereon (collectively, the “Playground”); and

WHEREAS, the Council will construct the Playground in accordance with applicable development requirements, the design of which shall be agreed upon jointly by the Council and the County’s Property Management Division; and

WHEREAS, the Council shall be responsible for all costs with respect to the design, approval and construction and equipping of the Playground, which may include a grant to the Council from the State of Maryland; and

WHEREAS, the Council has requested a grant from the County in the amount of \$250,000 to cover some of the costs of construction; and

WHEREAS, after completion of construction, the Council will donate the Playground, to be known as “Angel Park” to the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 306 of the Baltimore County Charter vests in the County Council the power to accept gifts and grants;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the County is authorized to accept on completion an all-inclusive playground and amphitheater facility from the Perry Hall Recreation & Parks Council on the property to be known as Angel Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect from the date of its passage by the County Council.
