Dear Mr. Goodyear:

This office has reviewed the information submitted on July 19, 2013 and finds that a variance can be granted for this project under Section 33-4-113 (a) (2) of Title 4 Storm Water Management of the Baltimore County Code. This section of the regulations allows a storm water management variance to be granted if there are exceptional circumstances such that strict adherence to the provisions of this article would result in unreasonable hardship or practical difficulty and not fulfill the intent of this article.

Specifically: On October 14, 2010 Preliminary Project Approval of the above referenced project was granted by DEPS. Approval with minor comments of the storm water management plans were obtained December 13, 2011 from DEPS. The last outstanding approvals are from DEPS – Storm Water Engineering and erosion and sediment control plans by SCD.
