FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
FINAL ORDER OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

This matter came before the Administrative Law Judge on February 21, 2012 for a Hearing on a citation for violations under the Baltimore County Code (BCC) section 13-4-201(d), failure to store garbage in container with tight fitting lids on residential property.

On January 23, 2012, pursuant to § 3-6-205, Baltimore County Code, Inspector Justin Olszewski issued a Code Enforcement & Inspections Citation. The citation was sent to the Respondent by 1st class mail to the last known address listed in the Maryland State Tax Assessment files.

The citation proposed a civil penalty of \$75.00 (seventy five dollars).

The following persons appeared for the Hearing and testified: Cynthia Hicksleeper, Respondent and, Adam Whitlock, Baltimore County Code Enforcement Officer.

Testimony revealed that the respondent had two trash cans with properly fitting lids at the time that she left for work the day before trash was to be picked up at her residence. However, someone stole her two good trash cans and left an illegal can in its place with trash flowing out of the top of that one can. Based on this testimony and evidence, the respondent shall be found to be not guilty.

Having heard the testimony and evidence presented at the Hearing:

IT IS ORDERED by the Administrative Law Judge that the respondent be and is hereby found to be Not Guilty.
