

WHAT IS THE WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM?

The Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP), helps eligible low income households with the installation of energy conservation materials in their dwelling units. These measures both reduce the consumption of energy and the cost of the maintenance of these homes.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

All applicants must be income eligible (currently 200% of poverty) and able to prove ownership of the housing unit. For rental units, landlords must prove ownership and also agree to participate and invest.

Please review the income limits prior to requesting an application for assistance to ensure program eligibility.


APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

- Baltimore County Residence
- Head of Household
- 18 years or older
- Proof of identity and residency
- Provide names, ages and social security numbers and family relationships for all household members
- Provide documentation for income received by all household members

Priority classifications for applications are as follows:

- Elderly
- Handicapped
- Homeowners
- Households with children
- Households with high energy use according to utility information
- Households with income below poverty levels

Each applicant's household may receive only one weatherization grant during any program year. A dwelling unit may only be weatherized once during the life of the program, unless weatherization occurred prior to September 20, 1994.



SERVICE DELIVERY OPTIONS

Once eligibility is determined by the Baltimore County Department of Planning, an energy audit inspection will be scheduled. If the existing condition of the dwelling permits, the program may provide the following treatments to make the unit more energy efficient:

- Blower door air infiltration reduction
- Insulation in the attic, floors and walls
- Hot water system improvements
- Lighting retrofit
- Furnace cleaning/tuning, safety repairs
- Health and safety items
- Burner retrofit or replacement
