

Rethink Pulaski Highway in Middle River

Baltimore County is exploring the potential for redevelopment of about 900 acres along a five-mile segment of Pulaski Highway (US 40). Contribute your thoughts as the County and a diverse group of stakeholders examine redevelopment scenarios for the area. Decisions about whether or when to redevelop property will be made by property owners.

Your input now will help craft a long-term vision that could guide redevelopment over the next 25 years.


