PAPER & CARDBOARD

- ✓ Newspaper (with all inserts)
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Catalogs
- ✓ Books
- ✓ Computer paper
- ✓ Mail
- ✓ Paperboard (e.g. cereal, frozen food and shoe boxes)
- ✓ Cardboard (flattened)
- ✓ Milk Cartons
- ✓ Juice Boxes



METAL & GLASS

- ✓ Aluminum and steel food and beverage cans
- ✓ EMPTY aerosol cans
- ✓ Aluminum foil
- ✓ Aluminum pie pans
- ✓ Glass bottles and jars (all colors)



PLASTICS

- ✓ Narrow-neck plastic bottles and jugs (♻️ - ♻️ recycling symbol)
- ✓ Wide-mouth plastic containers (e.g. butter, cottage cheese, peanut butter and yogurt containers)
- ✓ Rigid plastics (e.g. buckets, drinking cups, flower pots, kiddie pools, toys, etc.)

Remember...
These items are **not** collected in Baltimore County's Single Stream Recycling Program:

- ✗ Plastic bags 
- ✗ Styrofoam™
- ✗ "Clam shells" (e.g. salad containers)
- ✗ Used tissue/napkins
- ✗ Light bulbs
- ✗ Ceramics
- ✗ Drinking glasses
- ✗ Mirrors
- ✗ Scrap metal
- ✗ CD jewel cases
- ✗ Motor oil containers
- ✗ VHS tapes

Only a light rinse is necessary!
