The following questions have been received from prospective bidders

- 1.** Question: Sights: Please clarify what the County is looking for in terms of the front sight. Specifications 1.5 and 1.6 are confusing.

 Answer: The Tritium Meprolight sight is an illuminated tritium front sight post that will replace the factory front sight post.

 Specification 1.5 is revised as follows:

 1.5 Fixed iron front sight.

- 2.** Question: The Tritium Meprolight ML-31615 Green is an aftermarket part and should be installed on the weapon by a qualified gunsmith. The specifications state that the rifle must come assembled. Is it acceptable to send the Meprolight separately from the weapon?

 Answer: Specification 1.6 is revised as follows:

 1.6 Front Sight: Tritium Meprolight ML-31615 – green.
 Rear Sight: Magpul MBUS 248, color black.
 Sights may be shipped, uninstalled, with the weapon.
 These will be installed by the County's armorer.

- 3.** Question: Sling: Is this a single point sling or a single point sling "adapter"? If this is just the sling, the rifle will need an "adapter" to make it work. Will this need to be installed on the weapon?

 Answer: Specification 1.9 is revised as follows:

 Single Point Sling, Magpul MS4 QD Gen2 Mod#518 and Magpul ASAP QD (black) adapter. The County armorer will install these items.

- 4.** Question: Rail System: The specification description does not include what rail system the County needs. This item is an aftermarket part and is normally installed by a qualified gunsmith – does the County require it to be installed on the weapon prior to shipment to the County?

 Answer: Specification 1.8 Rail System is revised as follows:

 Picatinny Quad Rail System (Daniel Defense Omega Rail 7.0 Carbine), Black anodized aluminum. This item replaces the factory handguard and is to be installed by the successful vendor.

- 5.** Question: Optics/Lights: The AimPoint Pro and Streamlight TLR-1 HL may not come assembled on the weapon as they are subject to mfg. availability. Is it acceptable to the County to ship these items separately?

Answer: The County will allow these two items to be shipped separately, if availability is a problem. The successful vendor will notify the County promptly if availability is delayed.

6. Specification 3 is revised as follows:
 3. Rifles are to be quoted FOB destination, with all options specified. The County will assemble certain options as indicated. The County prefers that all required parts/options be included and shipped with the weapon. Exceptions may be made with approval by the County and at our sole discretion. Invoices may not be issued until all parts/options have been received to make weapons complete.
7. All other terms and conditions remain the same.
