Volunteer Background Check Program

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Purpose

Baltimore County Government is invested in increasing the safety of participants and families while they are participating in Recreation and Parks activities and programs. We are extending our efforts to include conducting background investigations for all volunteers who participate in Recreation/ Nature Council, Therapeutic, PAL, and other County-sponsored recreation programs.

The background investigation will include of a review of each applicants criminal history and the development of an Investigative Report. The results of the investigation will determine each volunteer's eligibility to volunteer in our programs.

This program is a preventive measure. It is not meant to take the place of parental involvement and participation. It is meant to work in partnership with parental efforts to ensure that their children and all constituents enjoy programs and activities in a safe environment.





CRITERIA

Any person found guilty of offenses in the following categories listed below will not be approved:

- Inclusion on the National Sex Offender Registry
- Child Abuse
- Felony Assault (within the last 5 years)
- Possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute (within the last 5 years)
- Indecent Exposure (within the last 5 years)
- Misappropriation of Funds
- Statutory Rape
- Rape
- Felony Robbery
- Assault-First Degree Felony
- Vulnerable Adult Abuse Physical Injury -Felony
- Abuse/Neglect of a Vulnerable Adult-Custodian
- Murder
- Attempted Murder

PARENT PARTICIPATION

Parents are encouraged to remain active and supportive in their child's participation in Recreation and Parks programs by:

- Being aware of and involved in your child's daily experiences.
- Being available and prepared to listen.
- Teaching your child preventive communication skills.
- Nurturing your child's sense of self-esteem.
- Coming to us or your local Recreation/Nature Council with questions or concerns.

PROCESS

- Access the Volunteer Application by going to the following website www.ssci.com. Public computer labs are located at the Randallstown Community Center, Sollers Point Multi-Purpose Center, Dundalk Community Centers, and all Baltimore County Public Libraries.
- If you are unable to access the internet please obtain the Volunteer Background Investigation Forms from your community recreation office.
- Instructions for completing the forms (paper/online) are available at your community recreation office.
- Once the applications has been submitted in person or on line, it takes up to 5 business days to receive the results.
- If a report comes back with information preventing you from volunteering SSCI will contact you to report the findings.
- If you are approved for participation your name will be listed on the County's website at: www.baltimorecountymd.gov/recreationvolunteers
- Volunteers must complete this process annually.
- There is no cost to applicants.

Who must complete the background investigation:

- Board of Recreation and Parks Members
- Recreation/Nature Council Board Members
- Recreation/Nature Council Chairpersons
- Head and Assistant Coaches
- Instructors and Assistant Instructors
- Volunteers who have care, custody or control of children
- Volunteers who have access to confidential information (example: registration forms, financial information)
